

Lewisville Public Safety Advisory Committee
February 11, 2014

I. Call to Order

- A. Harlan Cobert, vice chair, called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. Members present were Laura Morris, Mike Gravelle and Harlan Cobert. Also present was Town Manager Hank Perkins and Deputy David McGuire.

II. Approval of Minutes

- A. Mrs. Morris moved to approve the minutes of December 10, 2013 as presented and Mr. Gravelle seconded. The vote was unanimous.

III. Old Business

- A. Request from Vartan Malatlian
1. The committee once again reviewed the request by Mr. Malatlain for speed control on his street.
 - a. Deputy McGuire then explained what the deputies had been doing in the way of a traffic study over the last two months. A decision to conduct this study was made by the committee and Corporal Eric Osborne at the December meeting. This was in keeping with the Residential Traffic Control policy.
 - b. Deputy McGuire reported that officers were able to work 26 separate days in the area between December 12 and January 6. The times the officers were in the area varied. During their observations, the speeds were 25 MPH or less. There were three tickets written during this period for speeds of 37 in a 25, 38 in a 25 and 40 in a 25.
 2. Based on the results, the committee felt there was nothing to warrant further action. A motion was made by Harlan Cobert and seconded by Mike Gravelle to take no further official action, other than to have deputies continue to monitor the street.
 3. The committee members noted that they were asked to consider speed and volume of traffic and in both cases were satisfied that no serious issues of concern were observed. As to volume, these are public streets and, therefore, accessible by other than neighborhood residents.

IV. New Business

- A. Solar Radar Unit
1. Mr. Perkins reviewed the speed sign, the Safe Pace 100 Speed Sign, with the committee. This is a solar powered radar unit. It is smaller than the traffic trailer and weighs about 21 pounds.
