He noted that it had been decided that staff would be involved in the in-depth process of updating the plan and that would be brought back to the Board for their review. He then reviewed the spread sheet with the Board and staff. He said overall, not a lot has changed in terms of vision of the town in the future. He pointed out that providing facilities and more services were high vote getters, but on the opposite end was an overwhelming desire to keep the tax rate low.

1. There was a discussion of the survey question on what people thought would make Lewisville a better place to live and work.
 - a. Mr. Kron stated that he used a "key word count." Out of 1400 responses, restaurants, leaf and limb pick up, small town feel, services like sewer and sidewalks and traffic control were at the top of the list.
