Meeting Minutes

November 10, 2015 - 6:00 p.m.

1. **Call to Order**

- a. Chair Robert Syvertson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Committee members present were Laura Morris, Scott Alderman and Cpl. Chris Davenport. Staff member Lynn Hall was also present.

3. **Adoption of Minutes**

- a. The minutes of the July 14, 2015 meeting were adopted as presented.

4. **New Business**

- a. Committee meeting schedule
 - i. The committee voted to meet quarterly going forward with first meeting of 2016 in January. In addition, it was also voted to change the meeting time to 5:30 p.m. since Fire Chief Alderman had a conflict.
- b. Newsletter information
 - i. Ms. Hall advised the committee on the submission of Safety Notes to be included in Town Newsletter due to space restraints. She asked that information be submitted in bullet format rather than paragraph.
- c. Speeding in the Bradford Place neighborhood
 - i. Mr. Conner was present to advocate for his neighbors by requesting speed bumps be placed to slow traffic.
 - ii. Chief Alderman stated that speed bumps slow emergency vehicles and is rough on emergency vehicles as well.
 - iii. Officer Davenport said that his department had only one (1) complaint from Bradford Place during 2015. A previous traffic study has been done in Bradford Place and a 24-hour monitor was there at one time, but not since streets have been re-paved. In addition, a speed trailer has been used, did not do much good. Cpl. Davenport invited Mr. Conner and his neighbors to call or email him at any time concerning speeding traffic. He will also check with other officers and he will talk to the town about putting trailer out again.
 - iv. There was discussion on whether stop signs could be erected and it was stated that stop signs create hazards of their own.
- d. Gunfire in neighborhood
 - i. Ray Wheeler complained of gunfire near his home.
- e. Chief Alderman emphasized the use of smoke detectors and that he had passed out pamphlets to visitors at Lewisville Elementary School.
