PROCLAMATION 2020003  
AMENDING THE TOWN OF LEWISVILLE'S  
STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION**

**WHEREAS**, At 1:30 p.m. on March 27, 2020 the Town of Lewisville amended its March 20, 2020 State of Emergency Declaration to include "Stay-At-Home" directives necessary to protect the health and safety of its residents from the COVID-19 virus.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED THAT THE TOWN'S STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1: STATE OF EMERGENCY.** The Town's State of Emergency Declaration adopted March 20, 2020, remains in full force and effect and is amended as follows:

**SECTION 2: STAY AT HOME DIRECTIVE EXPIRATION.** The Town of Lewisville's "STAY AT HOME" directive of March 27, 2020 will expire at 12:01 am, Friday, April 24, 2020.

**SECTION 3: UPON EXPIRATION.** Immediately upon expiration, the Town of Lewisville will be subject to the North Carolina "Stay-at-Home Order" of March 27, 2020, while it remains in effect, and all current and subsequent North Carolina Executive Orders.

**SECTION 4: CONTINUE STAY SAFE PRACTICES:** The COVID-19 virus is still a threat to our community. Residents are urged to continue stay safe practices of Stay At Home, Social Distancing, Hand Hygiene and avoiding groups of more than 10 people and use face masks whenever social distancing of 6 feet or more is difficult.


